



MINI-LESSON 26: PARTICIPIAL ADJECTIVES (-ED VS. -ING)

◆ What Are Participial Adjectives?

Participial adjectives are formed from **verbs** and usually end in **-ed** or **-ing**. They describe feelings or things that cause feelings.

Ending	Use for...	Example
-ed	How someone feels	I'm bored . (I feel bored.)
-ing	What causes the feeling	This movie is boring .

📌 More Examples:

- She was **interested** in the story.
- The story was **interesting**.
- He felt **confused**.
- The instructions were **confusing**.
- They were **annoyed**.
- The neighbors were very **annoying**.
- The children were **amused**.
- The clown was **amusing**;
