



MINI-LESSON 5: NUMBERS, DATES, AND TIME

Objective

Learn how to say and write **numbers**, **dates**, and **time** in English.

Numbers

► Cardinal Numbers (for quantity)

1 – one
2 – two
3 – three
4 – four
5 – five

10 – ten
20 – twenty
30 – thirty
100 – one hundred
1,000 – one thousand

Examples:

- I have **three** dogs.
- She is **twenty** years old.

► Ordinal Numbers (for order)

1st – first
2nd – second
3rd – third
4th – fourth

5th – fifth
10th – tenth
21st – twenty-first
100th – one hundredth

Examples:

- Today is **my first day**.
- He lives on the **fifth floor**.



Dates

► How to Say the Date

Month + ordinal number (+ year)

 Examples:

- April 22nd
- July 4th, 1776
- December 25th

 Spoken: "**April twenty-second**"

 Written: April 22, 2025 / 22 April 2025 (UK)

Common Mistake:

 Today is 22

 Today is **the 22nd of April** or **April 22nd**

Time

► How to Say the Time

Use "**o'clock**", **past**, or **to**:

Time	How to Say It
------	---------------

3:00	It's three o'clock
------	---------------------------

3:15	It's quarter past three
------	--------------------------------

3:30	It's half past three
------	-----------------------------

3:45	It's quarter to four
------	-----------------------------

3:10	It's ten past three
------	----------------------------

3:50	It's ten to four
------	-------------------------

 Tip:

- Use "**past**" for 1–30 minutes
- Use "**to**" for 31–59 minutes



When we use “past” and “to,” we always use 5-minute intervals.

- Say twenty past three (not twenty-one past three)
- Say ten to one (not eleven to one)

You can also say:

- It's 3:15 → “**Three fifteen**”
- It's 6:45 → “**Six forty-five**”
- It's 7:27 → “**Seven twenty-seven**”

 **AM** (morning) / **PM** (afternoon/evening)

- 7:00 AM = morning
- 7:00 PM = evening
